John 15:18-20	¹⁸ “If the world hates you, you know that it has hated Me before <i>it hated</i> you. ¹⁹ If you were of the world, the world would love its own; but because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, because of this the world hates you. ²⁰ Remember the word that I said to you, ‘A slave is not greater than his master.’ If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you;
John 16:1-4	These things I have spoken to you so that you may be kept from stumbling. ² They will make you outcasts from the synagogue, but an hour is coming for everyone who kills you to think that he is offering service to God. ³ These things they will do because they have not known the Father or Me. ⁴ But these things I have spoken to you, so that when their hour comes, you may remember that I told you of them. These things I did not say to you at the beginning, because I was with you.

John 14:25-26	²⁵ “These things I have spoken to you while abiding with you. ²⁶ But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you.
John 15:26	When the Helper comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, <i>that is</i> the Spirit of truth who proceeds from the Father, He will testify about Me,

John 16:12-14	¹² I have many more things to say to you, but you cannot bear <i>them</i> now. ¹³ But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come. ¹⁴ He will glorify Me, for He will take of Mine and will disclose <i>it</i> to you.

Galatians 1:6-7	⁶ I am amazed that you are so quickly deserting Him who called you by the grace of Christ, for a different (<i>heteros</i>) gospel; ⁷ which is really not another (<i>allos</i>).
2 Cor 11:4	For if one comes and preaches another (<i>allos</i>) Jesus whom we have not preached, or you receive a different (<i>heteros</i>) spirit which you have not received, or a different (<i>heteros</i>) gospel which you have not accepted, you bear <i>this</i> beautifully.

John 13:3	<i>Jesus</i> , knowing ... that He had come forth from God and was going back to God.
John 16:28	I came forth from the Father and have come into the world; I am leaving the world again and going to the Father.
John 1:1	In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
John 1:14	And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us.
John 16:7	But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you.

John 16:27	for the Father Himself loves you, because you have loved Me and have believed that I came forth from the Father .
